

SUPERVISED VISITATION RULES
FOR CAREGIVERS AND ADULT PARTICIPANT(S)

1. I will not make any promises to my children that could possibly upset them if not fulfilled such as coming home or buying extravagant gifts.
2. I will not speak negatively to my child including my comments about the other parent, family members or the legal system. If I have concerns, I will speak to my attorney about those issues.
3. When talking to my child, I will not use language that is abusive or destructive to my child, including speaking about the other parent negatively.
4. I will not physically discipline my child. I will use age-appropriate and non-physical discipline with my child such as redirecting, distraction, and time out. If help is needed, I will ask the supervision worker.
5. I will talk to my child about how they are in a positive manner. I understand that questioning my child about any abuse or attempting to get my child to change their story is not a good way to spend my time with my child. If I have any concerns, I will speak to my attorney.
6. I will treat my child with respect and kindness. I will not punish, berate, or blame my child for making allegations of abuse against me or another family member.
7. If I bring gifts or clothing for my child, I will allow my child to take the gifts at the end of the visitation. I will show the supervisor the gifts before giving to the child.
8. I will not whisper with my child during visitations. All conversations with my child will be in a normal tone of voice that can be heard by staff observing the visit. I will only speak in English.
9. I understand when I do not show up my child/ren are disappointed. I will make every effort to make all my visits. If I can't attend a scheduled visit, I will notify the supervision worker at least 24 hours in advance. I will arrive on time for my visits. I understand that if I am more than 15 minutes late, my visit may be canceled unless I have made other arrangements with the other party and the supervision worker.
10. I will not speak negatively of my child's other parent.

11. I will not use my cell phone during the visitation without prior reasons. This is a time to spend with your child and not to be on the phone with others. Moderate music may be acceptable. Pictures are acceptable. The visit will not be audio-recorded or video-recorded by either party. I will not send a recording device in with my child to the visit.
12. I understand if I show up for visitation under the influence of drugs or alcohol, I will be asked to leave and will not be allowed contact with my child(ren). The visit will not be made up.
13. I will not bring pets to the visitation for the safety of all unless agreed upon prior by all parties.
14. I understand that visitation is primarily for the child and parent. Any visits with other relatives must be arranged and approved by all parties prior to the visit. Approval must be received by the supervision worker in writing.
15. I understand I am not to provide my child with a phone number or address where I can be reached unless previously approved by the Court and all parties.
16. I understand I am not to ask my child for a phone number or address unless previously approved by the Court and all parties.
17. I understand I am not to bring any weapons to the visitation. Weapons will not be tolerated and the visit will end.
18. I understand I am not to talk to the supervisor about the legal case during the visit.
